Playing in the Bowmer Theatre (indoors):

**The Taming of the Shrew:** Set against a backdrop of beach boardwalks and rock 'n' roll.

**My Fair Lady:** One of the most exquisite musicals ever written.

**A Streetcar Named Desire:** An epic Pulitzer Prize-winning classic.

**The Tenth Muse:** A world premiere set in an 18<sup>th</sup>-century Mexican convent where young nuns have unearthed the script of a ribald farce written by a dead sister.
