



## Marin Shakespeare Company Tech Intern Program 2010

Marin Shakespeare Company presents award-winning outdoor summer Shakespeare performances at the Forest Meadows Amphitheatre on the campus of Dominican University in San Rafael, California, twelve miles north of San Francisco. Our Tech Intern Program, new this year, will give students an opportunity to learn about every phase of theatre production, and to specialize in one or more areas of choice.

The Tech Intern Program will accept high school students, as well as adults. We will accept up to four Tech Interns. Each Intern will receive a stipend of \$300. Our goal is to give interested students an opportunity to learn about all phases of production, and to train students who may become theatre technicians of the future.

The program will include approximately 30 hours of seminars/observation in:

- Artistic Direction
- Stage Management
- Set Design and Construction
- Lighting Design
- Prop Design
- Scenic Art
- Costume Design
- House Management
- Theatre Administration

In addition, Interns will choose one or more area of specialization for additional hands-on, participatory learning. Interns will be expected to complete at least 30 hours in one or more chosen areas.

Instructors will include Marin Shakespeare Company's Artistic Director, Managing Director, Technical Director, and Stage Manager.

Interns will attend at least one production meeting, rehearsal, and performance, and will be invited to all.

  - Travesties*: July 2 - August 15
  - The Taming of the Shrew*: July 16 - September 26
  - Antony and Cleopatra*: August 20 - September 25
- Each Intern's Schedule will be created around the student's availability and area of specialization.
