Professional Actor Training Intern Program 2017

Marin Shakespeare Company presents award-winning outdoor summer Shakespeare performances at the Forest Meadows Amphitheatre on the campus of Dominican University in San Rafael, California, twelve miles north of San Francisco. The Intern Program is an opportunity to study and perform as part of a professional summer theatre company. We accept current college students, college graduates, and other adults. The program gives you tools to learn how to bridge the gap between building acting skills, and figuring out how to work in the theatre profession. You will practice your craft, discuss the business of acting, make valuable professional contacts, and learn from being part of a large company of working actors at various stages of their careers.

The program includes six weeks of classes in skills such as: Shakespearean Acting, Audition/Business of Acting, Stage Combat and Voice. Classes vary each summer and are taught by members of the professional company and guest artists including Artistic Director Robert Currier.

- Classes: June 6 - August 12, Tuesdays - Fridays from 1:00 to 5:00 pm,
- Rehearsals: Additional evenings and weekends.
- Performances: (Forest Meadows Amphitheatre)
Much Ado About Nothing: June 23 - July 23
The Three Musketeers: July 28 - August 27
Love's Labour's Lost: September 1 - 24

All Interns will be offered ensemble casting in at least one mainstage play and may gain Equity Membership Candidate (EMC) points. In addition, Interns will perform a Showcase of scenes, monologues and stage combat work from the summer classes on **Saturday, August 12 at 5:00 pm**. Your casting will depend on your available dates, as well as the needs of each production. For Interns who wish to gain experience teaching Shakespeare to youth, there are opportunities to assist at summer Shakespeare camps for youth.

An audition in person or by video is recommended but not required. We generally accept 8 to 12 Intern students each summer.

Housing is not provided; however in the past we have been able to provide housing as a portion of a scholarship award to one or more Interns per summer. San Rafael is very close to San Francisco so any of the surrounding counties (Sonoma, San Francisco, Contra Costa) are just a short drive to San Rafael.

The EMC program is offered by Actor's Equity Association. All Interns may join the EMC program if they wish. EMC members gain points, or weeks, towards eligibility to join Actor's Equity Association.

The fee for the Intern Program is \$950, which does not include housing, transportation or personal expenses. Please see the scholarship information attached. To apply, mail your application to:

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Application

Scholarships are awarded to students who would not otherwise be able to afford to participate in the Intern Program and are based on financial need and artistic promise. We award both partial and full tuition waivers, as well as limited free housing. If you wish to apply for a scholarship, please complete this page of the application and submit it with the following attachments:

- Copy of student's or parent's most recent Internal Revenue Service Form 1040.
- An interview and/or other documentation may be requested.
- You may also include a paragraph describing why you are requesting a scholarship, and how much you are requesting. We give some full and some partial scholarships; this may be a fee waiver of \$450 or \$900 of the tuition amount. We will also try to provide free housing for at least one student each year, as a portion of a scholarship award.

FREE or LOW COST HOUSING SCHOLARSHIPS

Marin Shakespeare can sometimes provide housing for out-of-town Interns, usually in a private home of a Board member or supporter. Housing is available on a very limited basis. We cannot always locate free or low cost housing. Housing will typically include a private bedroom and access to bath, kitchen, and laundry facilities, and will not include meals or transportation. We also have some information about local rentals. Please let us know if you would like us to try to assist with your housing.
