There will be some afternoon rehearsals Wednesday, Thursday and Fridays. You will not be called to every rehearsal. Tech Rehearsals are generally from noon to midnight.

**Performances** Performances are Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sundays at 8 pm and Sundays at 4 pm. There will also be 11 AM Student Matinees of *Dream*.
