



Forest Meadows Amphitheatre - Updated August 18, 2021

In accordance with County of Marin and State guidelines, Marin Shakespeare Company (MSC) is offering events at the Forest Meadows Amphitheatre in the summer of 2021. Participants understand and acknowledge that MSC cannot guarantee the health or safety of all attendees. This Plan outlines the processes and procedures MSC will implement to ensure the maximum safety for all participants. People who have underlying health conditions that put them at particular risk from COVID-19 should consider not attending events at the Forest Meadows Amphitheatre in 2021.

Venue Protocols. All rules are subject to change:

1. **Be Respectful of Others:** Please be respectful, patient, and kind to others, recognizing that everyone has special needs.
2. **Proof of Vaccination or Testing:** You will be required to show proof of vaccination or recent negative COVID test at the door when attending ticketed events.
3. **Face Coverings:** Due to the delta variant, we require face masks for all attendees at all times, except when actively eating or drinking.
4. **Physical Distancing:** Please be respectful of others and practice physical distancing from others not in your group at all times. When seating is not assigned, please seat yourself six feet away from others who are not in your group.
5. **Food and Drink:** No food or drink will be allowed at events.
6. **Healthy Hygiene Practices:** Attendees are encouraged to wash and/or sanitize hands frequently. Handwashing is available in the Forest Meadows restrooms. Hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance/exit.
7. **If You Feel Ill:** If you have any symptoms such as fever, coughing, or shortness of breath, please do not attend. Any person who experiences symptoms while at the Amphitheatre should go home immediately.
8. **MSC Staff:** MSC staff who interact with patrons will be vaccinated and masked at all times.
9. **Covid Designee:** In the event of a confirmed Covid-19 case, the designated staff person is Lesley Currier (415-499-4485 or lesley@marinshakespeare.org). Ms. Currier will be responsible for notifying exposed persons and the Marin County Health Department.
